

Continuity of Learning Plan - Revised for June 2020 (Stage 3)

On April 6th, we implemented our Stage 4 *Continuity of Learning Plan* to support K-12 learners with at-home learning plans, care for essential service worker children, and prioritized in-school support for vulnerable learners. Beginning on June 1st, we will implement a Stage 3 revision to our *Continuity of Learning Plan*.

In our Stage 3 plan, care for essential service worker (ESW) children and in-school support for vulnerable learners will continue, and at-home learning plans will continue to be supported by teachers and educational support staff. Stage 3 in-class instruction is **optional** for families.

Cedars is committed to supporting learners at home **and** at the school through the end of June 2020. There is no expectation that at-school learners will get *more* OR that at-home learners will get *less* instruction or support. The minimal learning standards being addressed currently in Stage 4, will continue to be the focus in our Stage 3 plan. In Stage 3, we are offering part-time in-class instruction / support for K-7 students *Monday to Thursday*, and part-time in-class support for high school students (8-12) on *Tuesdays and Thursdays*.

Beginning June 1st, the weekly schedule will be as follows:

It is our sincere hope that BC continues to move toward a Stage 1, full return to in-class instruction in September; however, our *Continuity of Learning Plan* for Stage 2 would be a slight variation on this schedule, with increased focus on in-class instruction over at-home learning plan support, increased time for high school students, and the addition of afternoon in-class support for K-7 learners.
